Introduced in April 2001, the Pupil Premium is a Government initiative that provides additional funding aimed at students from deprived backgrounds. The Pupil Premium is provided to support these students in reaching their full academic and social potential.

The Leadership Team allocates the money provided, in a way which best meets the needs of present students.

The Pupil Premium provides funding for students:

- Who have been in receipt of free school meals (FSM) at any points in the past 6 years (£935 per student).
- Who have been continuously looked after for the past six months (£1900 per student).
- Who are adopted from care under the Adoption and Children Act 2002 or who have left care under a Special Guardianship or Residence Order (£1900).
- For students whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces, or whose parent/carer is in receipt of a pension from the MoD (£300 per child).
