The percentage of A levels graded at A* to C has risen significantly to an impressive 79% with half of all entries graded at A*-B. The overall pass rate for our A levels is 98%. Equally impressive, is the pass rate for our Level 3 vocational and technical courses at 97% with most of the grades awarded at the very highest levels. We are immensely proud of our students' achievements and these results reflect their hard work, commitment and determination. Two of our students, Evvia Gonzales and Felix Prutton, have been successful in gaining entry to the University of Cambridge where they will be studying Natural Sciences; Evvia at St. John's and Felix at Downing.
