Curriculum Structure 2016-17

The school operates a 2 week timetable, with 15 100-minute lessons per week. The following tables show how the 30 lessons per fortnight are spread across the different subjects our students study, in their broad and balanced curriculum.

Years 7-9

*Technology operates a 'rotation' system, where students are able to experience the range of technology subjects in year 7,8 and 9.

Some of our students in years 7-9 follow a reduced version of this curriculum to allow for additional learning support in English and maths.

Years 10-11

During year 9, students take their GCSE options, and select 4 subjects from across the curriculum. Students are asked to select at least one from the 'EBacc' range of subjects (languages, history, geography, computer science). Students also receive teaching in citizenship in their PE groups. In year 11, around 30 students spend one day each week at a local vocational course provider, completing a level 1 or level 2 course. Sixth Form

Students in the sixth form receive 6 lessons every 2 weeks in each of their AS or A level options.

Students on non-A level courses run for sixth form students receive 12 to 18 lessons per fortnight.

Students who are resitting English and/or maths GCSE at the sixth form have 2 lessons teaching in each subject every 2 weeks.
